Missions Moment

As we remember the missionaries that we support by giving and praying, here are some recommendations of what to pray for as we bring our petitions to Our Lord.

PRAY FOR OPEN DOORS

"Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful. And pray for us, too, that God may open a door for the message..." Colossians 4:2-3

Open doors can't be taken for granted. Many missionaries work in countries that are difficult to access or in areas that are resistant to the gospel. But open doors include more than just access to nations and people groups. Individuals' hearts also need to be open and receptive to God's truth. **PRAY**

- ♦ that God would open doors of ministry, blessing partnerships and friendships.
- ♦ that those who serve will be led by the Holy Spirit and recognize open-door opportunities.
- ♦ that God would lead His people past barriers to hearts ready to receive His Word.

PRAY THAT GOD'S WORD WILL SPREAD

Finally, dear brothers and sisters, we ask you to pray for us. Pray that the Lord's message will spread rapidly and be honored wherever it goes, just as when it came to you. 2 Thessalonians 3:1

Obstacles must be removed to allow God's Word to spread rapidly and freely, and missionaries need the strength to continue in the face of opposition or difficulties. Just as Aaron and Hur supported Moses' arms in the battle against the Amalekites (Exodus 17:12), you can strengthen the arms of missionaries by supporting them through your prayers. **PRAY**

- ♦ for strength and stamina as missionaries encounter antagonistic spiritual forces. Ephesians 6:10-18
- ♦ that people will resist Satan's plans to obstruct the spread of the gospel. James 4:7
- ♦ that God's Word will indeed spread rapidly and be honored wherever it goes.
